## **West Haven Twilight League Weekly Recap: June 18-23**

### **Columbus Auto Body 5, Bank of Southern CT 0**

Columbus benefited from a masterful performance from pitcher Joe Smergalino. Smergalino allowed just two hits and a walk as he went the distance to earn the victory. On the offensive side, Columbus scored all five of their runs in the fifth inning with Marc Potocsky and Mark Tamsin each driving in two.
